

Terms & Conditions | HOMs Web App

Effective Date: July 21, 2026

These Terms & Conditions (“Terms”) govern access to and use of the HOMs Web App and related products and services provided by Helper of Mothers LLC (“HOMs,” “we,” “us,” or “our”). By creating an account, purchasing a subscription, accessing the HOMs Box, or otherwise using the Services, you agree to these Terms and any policies incorporated into them.

1. Definitions

“Services” means the HOMs Web App and any related features, tools, content, scheduling services, and support services that HOMs makes available.

“HOMs Box” means the digital library of downloadable, printable, audiovisual, or other educational resources made available through HOMs Premium.

“HOMs Content” means content created or owned by Helper of Mothers LLC, including the HOMs Web App, original HOMs resources, branding, designs, text, graphics, and software.

“Contributor Content” means educational materials owned by third-party creators, publishers, curriculum providers, or other contributors and licensed to HOMs for inclusion in the HOMs Box or related Services. Contributor Content may include individual worksheets, printable packets, lesson plans, unit studies, assessments, answer keys, projects, educational guides, videos, audio, curriculum units, complete curricula, and similar learning materials.

2. Account and Eligibility

- The person creating an account must be at least 18 years old and legally able to enter into a contract.
- Children may use the Services only through and under the supervision of a parent or legal guardian.
- You agree to provide accurate, current information and to keep your account information updated.
- You are responsible for protecting your login credentials and for activity occurring through your account. You may not share your account with another household or unauthorized user.

3. Services Provided

HOMs may provide academic logging, homeschool recordkeeping, portfolio tools, planning resources, Social Emotional Learning tools, access to the HOMs Box, in-home helper scheduling, co-op helper services, and other related features.

HOMs is a homeschool support company and software provider. HOMs is not a school, accredited educational institution, government agency, legal advisor, healthcare provider, or guarantee of homeschool compliance.

Features, resources, and availability may change as the Services develop. HOMs may add, modify, suspend, or discontinue a feature or resource, subject to applicable law and any commitments that apply to an active paid term.

4. Free and Premium Access

HOMs may offer a free version and one or more paid Premium plans. The features included in each plan will be described in the app or at checkout.

The HOMs Box and other Premium features may be available only while a Premium subscription is active. Subscription fees purchase access to the Premium Services as a whole and do not purchase ownership of, or permanent access to, any specific resource, curriculum, contributor, or feature. HOMs does not guarantee that a particular resource, contributor, or feature will remain available indefinitely.

5. Subscriptions, Billing, Automatic Renewal, and Cancellation

Payments are processed through Stripe or another payment processor identified at checkout. HOMs does not store complete payment card information.

Monthly and annual subscriptions automatically renew unless canceled before the applicable renewal date. The price, billing frequency, renewal terms, and any post-trial price will be presented at checkout. Pricing changes will apply no earlier than the next renewal period after any notice required by law.

Where required by law, HOMs will provide advance renewal or trial-ending notices and an accessible method of cancellation. A subscription purchased electronically may be canceled electronically through the account settings or another cancellation method made available by HOMs. You may also contact helperofmoms@gmail.com for assistance.

Cancellation stops future renewal charges but does not normally end access before the conclusion of the current paid billing period. Refund eligibility is governed by the HOMs Web App Refund & Cancellation Policy, which is incorporated into these Terms.

6. HOMs Box Resource License

While you have lawful access to the HOMs Box, HOMs grants you a limited, nonexclusive, nontransferable, revocable license to access, download, print, and use HOMs Content and Contributor Content solely for personal, noncommercial educational use within your household.

Permitted household use includes use by the account holder, the account holder's children, and a tutor, caregiver, or helper working directly with those children. Unless a resource expressly states otherwise or HOMs grants written permission, the license does not include use for a school, co-op, classroom, business, membership group, paid tutoring program, or multiple households.

You may retain and continue using copies lawfully downloaded during an active subscription for the permitted household purposes described above. You may not:

- resell, sublicense, publish, post, email, upload, distribute, or share a resource or account access with another household or the public;
- remove copyright notices, creator credits, trademarks, watermarks, or other ownership information;
- alter a resource and represent it as your own work;
- use automated tools to scrape, copy, or mass-download the HOMs Box; or
- use any resource for commercial purposes unless HOMs or the applicable owner gives written permission.

A resource-specific license or usage notice may grant additional permission. When it does, that notice applies to that resource.

7. Ownership of HOMs Content and Branding

HOMs Content, the HOMs Web App, and HOMs names, logos, designs, and branding are owned by or licensed to Helper of Mothers LLC and are protected by applicable intellectual-property laws.

Your subscription purchases access and a limited usage license. It does not transfer ownership of the Services or any content to you.

8. Third-Party Contributor Content

Contributor Content remains owned by its respective creator or rights holder and is made available through a license granted to HOMs. HOMs does not claim ownership of Contributor Content merely because it appears in the HOMs Box.

HOMs may display the contributor's name, business name, logo, website, social-media information, or other approved credit with the resource or in related promotional areas. Contributors are independent parties and are not employees, agents, partners, schools, or educational authorities of HOMs unless a separate written agreement expressly states otherwise.

HOMs may review, categorize, format, feature, suspend, replace, or remove Contributor Content. Inclusion in the HOMs Box does not constitute a guarantee or endorsement of the contributor, and HOMs does not guarantee that Contributor Content will be accurate, complete, suitable for every learner, continuously available, or produce a particular educational result.

Contributors who provide materials to HOMs are governed by a separate Content License and Promotional Exchange Agreement or other written agreement. Unless that separate written agreement expressly provides otherwise, a contributor's promotional credit or exposure does not create a right to royalties, download-based compensation, or any portion of HOMs subscription revenue. If a separate agreement conflicts with these Terms concerning the contributor's rights and obligations, the separate agreement controls for that contributor relationship.

9. User Content and Homeschool Records

You retain ownership of photographs, writing samples, academic logs, records, messages, and other materials that you upload or enter into the Services ("User Content").

You grant HOMs a limited, nonexclusive license to host, store, reproduce, process, transmit, and display User Content only as reasonably necessary to operate, secure, support, and improve the Services and to make the content available to you and any users you authorize.

You represent that you have the legal right to upload the User Content and that doing so does not violate another person's privacy, intellectual-property, or other rights.

You are responsible for the accuracy of your homeschool records and for retaining any separate backups or records required for your family. HOMs is not a government record repository and does not guarantee that use of the Services alone satisfies any legal recordkeeping requirement.

10. Prohibited Conduct

You may not use the Services to:

- violate any law or another person's rights;
- upload unlawful, infringing, deceptive, harmful, or malicious content;
- submit knowingly false homeschool, billing, identity, or account information;
- gain unauthorized access to another account, system, or data;
- interfere with the security or operation of the Services;
- reverse engineer, copy, scrape, or commercially exploit the Services except where applicable law does not permit that restriction;
- impersonate another person or misrepresent your relationship with HOMs; or
- collect or use another user's personal information without authorization.

11. Educational, Legal, and Third-Party Disclaimers

HOMs resources are supplemental educational and organizational materials. Families remain responsible for selecting curriculum, supervising instruction, evaluating suitability, complying with applicable homeschool laws, and making decisions for their children.

HOMs does not guarantee academic outcomes, legal compliance, acceptance of records by an oversight organization, eligibility for public funding, or the quality or availability of a third-party provider.

The Services may include links to or integrations with third-party services. HOMs is not responsible for the content, privacy practices, availability, or actions of those independent services.

Except as required by law, the Services and content are provided “as is” and “as available,” without warranties of any kind, whether express or implied. Nothing in these Terms limits a warranty, consumer right, or remedy that cannot lawfully be excluded.

12. Privacy

HOMs collects and uses personal information as described in the HOMs Privacy Policy. By using the Services, you acknowledge that you have reviewed that policy.

13. Suspension and Termination

You may stop using the Services at any time and may cancel a paid subscription as described above.

HOMs may suspend or terminate access when reasonably necessary because of nonpayment, a violation of these Terms, suspected fraud or security risk, unlawful conduct, a legal requirement, or conduct that could harm HOMs, its contributors, or its users.

When practical, HOMs may provide notice and an opportunity to correct a violation. Immediate suspension or termination may occur when necessary to protect users, data, intellectual property, or the Services.

Provisions that by their nature should continue after termination—including ownership, license restrictions, disclaimers, liability limitations, and payment obligations—will survive termination.

14. Limitation of Liability

To the fullest extent permitted by law, HOMs and its owners, officers, employees, contractors, and service providers will not be liable for indirect, incidental, special, consequential, exemplary, or punitive damages arising from the Services.

To the fullest extent permitted by law, HOMs’ total liability arising from or related to the Services will not exceed the amount you paid to HOMs for the applicable Service during the 12 months before the event giving rise to the claim.

These limitations do not apply where prohibited by law and do not waive any right or remedy that cannot legally be waived or limited.

15. Indemnification

To the extent permitted by law, you agree to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless HOMs and its owners, officers, employees, and contractors from third-party claims, losses, liabilities, and reasonable expenses arising from your unlawful misuse of the Services, your violation of these Terms, or User Content that you did not have the right to submit.

16. Changes to These Terms

HOMs may update these Terms as the Services, laws, or business practices change. The updated Terms will state a new effective date.

When required by law or when a change is material, HOMs will provide notice through the app, by email, or by another reasonable method. Continued use after the updated Terms take effect constitutes acceptance, except where applicable law requires additional consent.

17. Governing Law and Consumer Rights

These Terms are governed by the laws of the State of Maryland and applicable federal law, without regard to conflict-of-law principles.

Nothing in these Terms shortens any legally applicable period for bringing a claim, waives remedies that cannot lawfully be waived, or limits consumer protections that apply based on your place of residence.

18. Entire Agreement, Severability, and No Waiver

These Terms, the Privacy Policy, the Refund & Cancellation Policy, the terms displayed at checkout, and any separate written agreement applicable to a particular service form the agreement between you and HOMs concerning the Services.

If a provision of these Terms is found unenforceable, the remaining provisions will remain in effect to the fullest extent permitted by law.

A failure by HOMs to enforce a provision is not a waiver of the right to enforce it later.
